TRIAGE ASSESSMENT QUESTIONS

(Exception: These symptoms are transient and only present when coughing) Respiratory Distress (also known as Working Hard to Breathe or Shortness of Breath) Always rule out respiratory distress Listen for grunting, stridor, wheezing, tachypnea in respiratory calls How to assess: Listen to the child's breathing early in your assessment
